

## State of the Arts Conference November 18-21, 2010

Hosted on the beautiful UC San Diego main La Jolla campus  
located at 9500 Gilman Drive in La Jolla, California.

### **DRIVING DIRECTIONS:** *Traveling on Highway 5 (North or South)*

From I-5 exit Genesee Avenue and turn west. Turn left onto North Torrey Pines Road (the second traffic signal). Turn left onto North Point Drive (the first traffic signal). You will be at the North Point Drive entrance to campus (map). A UCSD visitor information center is on the right.

### **PLANES, TRAINS and AUTOMOBILES:**

**Taxi and paid shuttle** services are available from the San Diego International airport, which is about 20 miles from the UCSD campus.

**Amtrak:** the closest Amtrak stop to the UCSD campus is Solana Beach. Taxi service is available in Solana Beach or the 101 Bus South goes to campus and has a stop at the Estancia hotel (walking distance to campus). To book your reservation call Amtrak at (800) 872-7245.

**The Coaster:** A rail system runs from the downtown San Diego train station to North County. The nearest campus stop is the Sorrento Valley Train Station, where free shuttle service is available to campus.

### Campus Shuttle Service

#### UCSD Campus Loop Shuttles

Shuttles marked with the yellow “L” run in both directions (clockwise and counterclockwise) weekdays every 10-15 minutes from 7 am to 11 pm.

On weekends buses run counterclockwise every 20 minutes from 9 am to 8 pm.



**Coaster** shuttles run weekdays between the Sorrento Valley Coaster Station and the UCSD La Jolla campus every 25-50 minutes between 6:00 am and 7:00 pm.



An east “C” and west “W” route runs during off-peak midday hours.
